Hawaiian Chili Peppers

Despite the common name, this species is not Hawaiian, but is commonly grown and used in the islands. Your Hawaiian Chile Pepper plant will grow very easily once established. Please keep your seedlings in a very warm spot in your garden and keep evenly watered. Hawaiian chilli peppers are used to make a popular condiment consisting of vinegar, water, salt, ginger, garlic and chillies just as Tabasco sauce.
